



## Neuland with Carol DuBosch – Supply List

Saturday, July 11 on ZOOM | 10am-12pm and 1:30-3:30pm

- Layout bond paper (8.5"x11" or 11"x17" or similar). My favorite is Capitol Bond (available at John Neal) Other layout papers might work also.
- Watercolor Paper (one piece 9"x12")
- Pencil & eraser
- 3-5 Watercolor pencils
- "waterbrush" or watercolor brush and a container of water
- Spray mister (optional)
- Pilot Parallel Pen – 6mm
- Automatic Pen size 5 and/or 4A (a wide poster pen approximately 1/2" wide)
- Ink – Choose a free-flowing ink like Higgins Eternal or Walnut
- One wooden clothes pin (the simple kind with the spring)
- Small piece of kitchen sponge (roughly 1" square) and a small container to hold the sponge.  
We will wet the sponge with ink and use it to ink the wood clothes pen. I call the system a "sponge inker".
